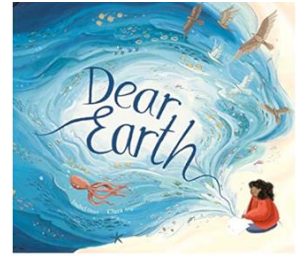
KLQ

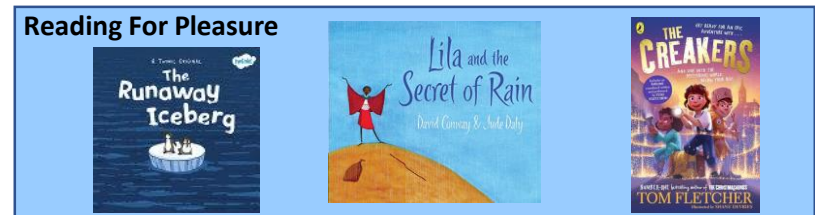

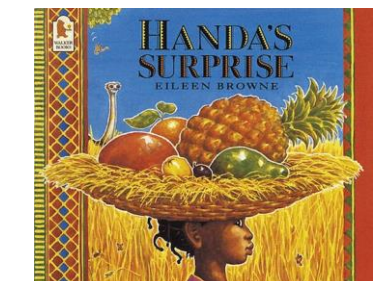

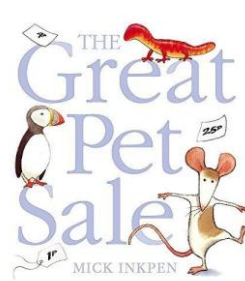
KL
