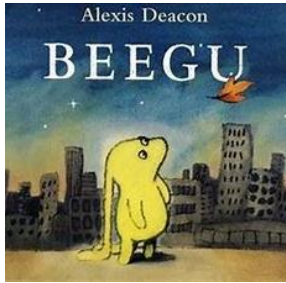
KL
